NTUST Swimming Pool Guidelines

- 1. Upon entry, please present identification, undergo verification, and make payment with the attendant before participating in the event.
- 2. Individuals suffering from any statutory infectious diseases, epilepsy, altered consciousness, skin conditions (including ulcers or wounds), multiple sclerosis, body discomfort, or a fever exceeding 37.5 degrees Celsius are strictly prohibited from entering the swimming pool.
- 3. Individuals suffering from malignant tumors, heart disease, diabetes, and other non-communicable diseases, as well as those holding disability certificates, must be accompanied throughout their time in the swimming pool by an adult family member. The accompanying family member is solely responsible for the behavior of the accompanied individual while using the swimming pool and shall bear full legal responsibility.
- 4. In accordance with the regulation, children under 12y must be accompanied by their parents or guardians. The same requirement applies to those whose height is below 120 cm.
- 5. To maintain the water quality and hygiene of the swimming pool, all individuals entering the pool must wear snug-fitting swimwear, swim trunks, and a swim cap.
- 6. Before entering the pool, it is mandatory to take a thorough shower, remove makeup, and refrain from applying moisturizers or other oily substances to the skin surface.
- 7. The use of flippers, goggles, and floating devices requires prior approval from lifeguards and facility staff.
- 8. Eyeglasses, necklaces, earrings, rings, glass containers, ceramic dishes, and other fragile items are strictly prohibited from entering the pool area.
- 9. Those using the long swim lane must adhere to the "keep right, turn left" direction and are prohibited from stopping midway.
- 10. Please take responsibility for the security of your personal belongings, and place your slippers in the designated shoe rack.
- 11. Diving is strictly prohibited in the swimming pool. Running, playing, diving, squatting, standing, or engaging in any behavior that may endanger the safety of others is prohibited around the pool area.

12. Swimmers engaging in behavior that poses a safety concern for the pool may be promptly stopped by the lifeguard. If individuals fail to comply with the lifeguard's instructions, they may be forcibly removed from the swimming pool.

13. No private coaching or training activities are allowed in the swimming pool area without prior permission from the sports facility.

14. Smoking, drinking alcohol, chewing betel nut or gum, as well as bringing in food, beverages, pets, and rain gear are strictly prohibited in the swimming pool area.

15. When there is no lifeguard on duty, individuals who swim in the pool do so at their own risk.
